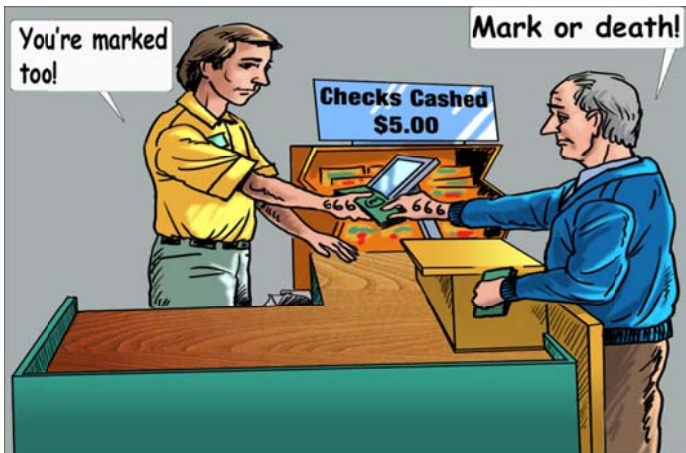
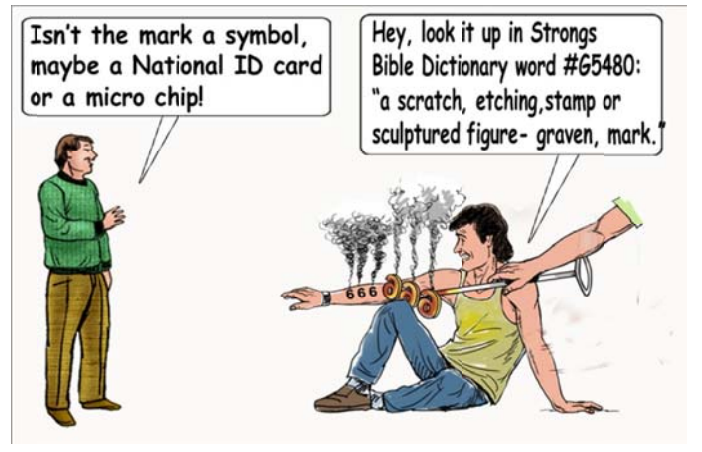
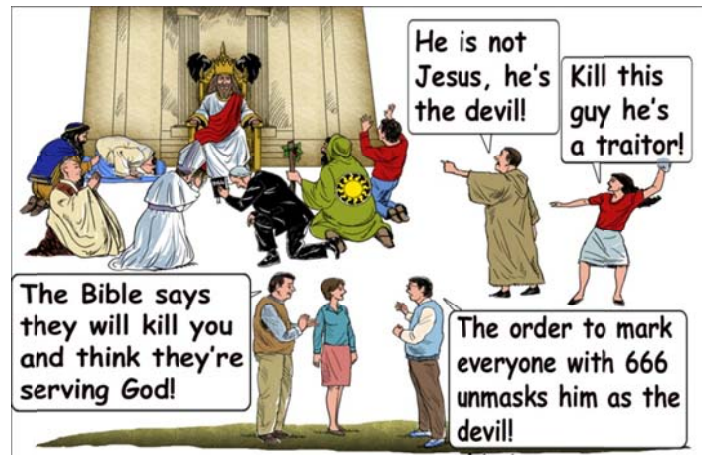
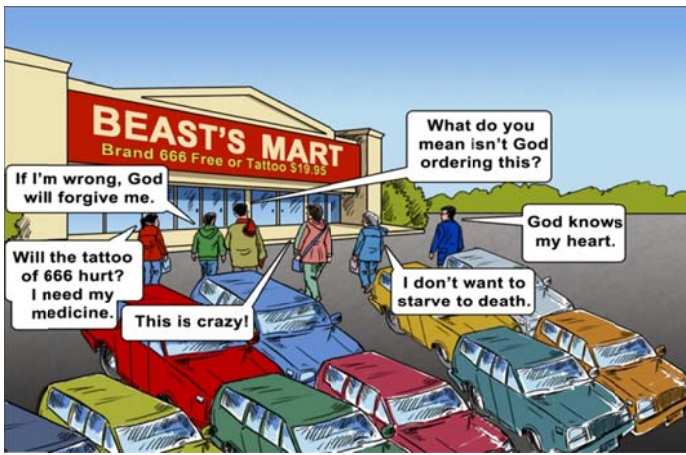




Death Decree 1040th Day
