Please read each column from top to bottom.

The purpose of this study is to show:

1. Jesus is a co-eternal member of the Godhead
2. Jesus is Jehovah, Lord God Almighty:
3. Jesus is Israel's King and Redeemer
4. Jesus is The Alpha and the Omega (means endless)
5. Jesus is The Beginning and the End (means endless)
6. Jesus will be the God of the redeemed
7. Jesus is The Almighty, Who is, who was, and who is to come

Isa 44:6 "This is what the LORD says-- Israel's King and Redeemer, **the LORD Almighty**: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God."

Rev 1:17, 18 "When I [John] saw him [Jesus], I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: "Do not be afraid. **I am the First and the Last**. I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades."

Rev 22:12-14 "Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done. **I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End**. Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city."

Rev 21:6,7 He [Jesus] said to me: "It is done. **I [Jesus] am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End**. To him who is thirsty I will give to drink without cost from the spring of the water of life. He who overcomes will inherit all this, and I [Jesus] will be his God and he will be my son."

Rev 1:8 "**I am the Alpha and the Omega**," says **the Lord God**, "who is, and who was, and who is to come, **the Almighty**."

Revelation 11:15-17 "The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he will reign for ever and ever." And the twenty-four elders, who were seated on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God, saying: 'We give thanks to you, **Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was**, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign.'"

1. Jesus is a separate and distinct God
2. Jesus is a God, just like the Father
3. Jesus has always been with the Father
4. Jesus has created everything that exists
5. Jesus existed before anything was made
6. Jesus is called Eternal God, The Lord, God Almighty, Jehovah and the Rock eternal
7. Jesus is worthy of worship - as Creator and Redeemer

The phrase, "the only begotten of the Father" cannot be used as a statement to support the idea that Christ is a created being. The Bible declares Christ is eternal (has no beginning) several times and using the phrase "only begotten son" to suggest that Christ was created puts the Bible in a state of internal conflict. The term is a title of endearment that goes back to Abraham's sacrifice. God called Isaac Abraham's "only [begotten] son" when in fact, Ishmael was also Abraham's son. (Gen 16:15, 22:2, 12, 16; John 3:16)

1 John 1:2 The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you **the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us**.

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was **with God in the beginning**. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory **as of the only begotten of the Father**;) full of grace and truth.

Col 1:16,17 For by him **all things were created**: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him **He is before all things**, and in him all things hold together.

Gen 17:1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to him and said, **"I am God Almighty**; walk before me and be blameless.
Gen 35:1 And God said to him, **"I am God Almighty** ; be fruitful and increase in number. A nation and a community of nations will come from you, and kings will come from your body.

Exo 6:2,3 God also said to Moses, "I am the LORD. I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob **as God Almighty**, but by my name the LORD (Jehovah) I did not make myself known to them.

Isa 26:4 Trust in the LORD forever, for the LORD, **the LORD, is the Rock eternal**.

1 Cor 10:4,5 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and **that Rock was Christ**. But with many of them God was not well pleased; for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

Gen 21:33 Abraham planted a tamarisk tree in Beersheba, and there he called upon the name of **the LORD, the Eternal God**.

Jesus is equal and identical to the Father in every way. They differ in roles. One serves as the Supreme Ruler of the Universe, the other serves as the Creator of everything that exists and the Redeemer of sinners.

Rev 14:6,7 Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had **the eternal gospel** to proclaim to those who live on the earth--to every nation, tribe, language and people. He said in a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come. **Worship him who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and the springs of water**."

Neh 9:5-7 And the Levites--Jeshua, Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah--said: "Stand up and praise **the LORD your God, who is from everlasting to everlasting**." "Blessed be your glorious name, and may it be exalted above all blessing and praise. You alone are the LORD. You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to everything, and the multitudes of heaven worship you. "You are **the LORD God, who chose Abram** and brought him out of Ur of the Chaldeans and named him Abraham.

Isa 40:25-28 "To whom will you compare me? Or who is my equal?" says the Holy One. Lift your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name. Because of his great power and mighty strength, not one of them is missing. Why do you say, O Jacob, and complain, O Israel, "My way is hidden from the LORD; my cause is disregarded by my God"? Do you not know? Have you not heard? **The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth**. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom."

John 5:22,23 Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, **that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father**. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.

John 1:10,11 He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him.

Phil 2:6-8 **[Jesus] Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped**, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross!
